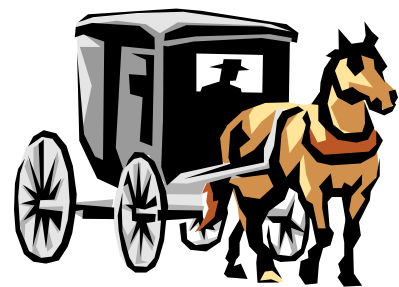


**Daily Life at
Redcliffe
Plantation
in the
19th Century**



Directions to Redcliffe Plantation State Historic Site:

From Aiken: Take SC 302 (Silver Bluff Road) South to US 278. Turn right going west for about two miles. You will see brown park signs for Redcliffe Plantation. Take the next left onto Hammond Road, then right onto Redcliffe Road.

From North Augusta (exit 1 off of Interstate 20): Take SC 125 (Atomic Road) South out of North Augusta to Beech Island. Turn right at stop light onto Beech Island Avenue then left onto US 278 at second stop light. Go two miles then right onto Hammond Road. Then right onto Redcliffe Road.

From Augusta: Take Broad Street east, which will turn into Sand Bar Ferry Road. Once you have crossed the river, then drive through Beech Island until road turns into US 278 going East (never turning off of Sand Bar Ferry Road). Go two miles then right onto Hammond Road. Then right onto Redcliffe Road.

Program Fees

Entrance to the park is free. The fees for an interpreter-led field trip at Redcliffe Plantation are as follows:

- 1-25 students \$20
- 25-40 students \$40
- 41-60 students \$60
- 61-80 students \$80
- 81-100 \$100

Chaperones are admitted free. The required chaperone ratio (unless otherwise noted) is **one** chaperone for every **ten** students.

Meeting Spot

The Interpretive Ranger will be in the Visitor Parking area when you arrive. The bus should be parked in this designated area.

What to Wear/Bring

Trash bags and lunch or snack (if applicable). Students should wear shoes at all times and name tags if at all possible. Note the weather on the day of your visit. There may be activities outdoors that require sunscreen or rain jackets/umbrellas. Please come prepared.

Students should also bring the pictures that they drew during the pre-visit activities. These will be used in an ice-breaking session before the house tour.

Special Instructions

The grounds of Redcliffe are host to mounds of fire ants that will bite. Please watch your step and do not disturb the mounds. Fire ant bites may cause an allergic reaction for some people. Notify a ranger if you require medical attention.

Materials Provided for Pre-site and Post-site Activities

- Hammond family tree and templates for students to create their own family trees
- Copies of primary source documents such as letters, photographs, and diary entries concerning Hammond family members

Teacher Preparation

Read lesson and activities completely and contact the Interpreter at Redcliffe Plantation SHS with any questions or concerns. Implement pre-site activities before the scheduled program. Allow 2 hours plus travel time for the program.
